Dear Slawomir, Dear colleagues,

The Executive Board of FSLI ROMANIA, representing 170.000 affiliated teachers and employees in education sector in Romania, expresses its support and declares its solidarity with all the protest actions that the teachers affiliated to ZNP organizes these days, including general strike.

The demands of trade union members are fully justified and many of them are also in our claim program.

Polish employees in education sector do not ask privileges from the Govern, they require decent wages and decent working conditions to provide a quality education.

We call on the political decision-makers in Poland to properly treat its employees in the education sector, do not pressure the members of the union, and reload urgently the negotiation with the trade unions in education in order to defuse the conflict and immediately satisfy all the claims!

The revolt of employees in Polish education is the effect of dissatisfaction over a long period of time, when they were treated with contempt, marginalized during the negotiations, probably as a consequence of weak Social Dialogue.

We support you in all your efforts at these times and, once again, we express our full solidarity with your trade union actions!
